The undergraduate certificate in Intelligence & National Security Studies (INSS) introduces students to the highly desired skills and competencies necessary to work within the US Intelligence Community.

Combining courses and extracurricular activities, the INSS certificate demonstrates to future employers that you are knowledgeable about the dynamic, multidisciplinary field of intelligence, its role in security and diplomacy, and the ethics and laws governing intelligence collection and dissemination. Open only to undergraduates.
